The Oklahoma Bankers Association is proud to promote, for the 50th year, the recognition of bankers who have devoted 50 or more years of service to the banking industry. All eligible nominees will be honored at the 2010 OBA Convention, at the Renaissance Hotel in Tulsa. The awards will be presented during the Incoming Chairman's Dinner at 7:00 p.m., May 25. Honorees will also be awarded a plaque commemorating this milestone and will be featured in the *Oklahoma Banker* newspaper.

Eligibility Requirements

- ◆ Fifty or more years of accredited banking service must be accumulated prior to Dec. 31, 2010.
- ◆ At least 10 years of banking in Oklahoma is required.
- ◆ The nominee must be **active** as a director, officer or employee of an Oklahoma bank or holding company at the time of nomination.
- ◆ Previous years of banking service in other states may be counted toward the 50-year total. If the nominee was in banking both before and after time served in the U.S. Military, that time will also count toward the 50-year total.
