## **Ponca City bankers help fight hunger in Oklahoma**

OKLAHOMA CITY — Erin Liberton, senior vice president at Eastman National Bank, and Shasta Scott, assistant vice president at Eastman National Bank, recently helped sort and pack more than 15,900 pounds of food for Oklahomans affected by hunger. Liberton and Scott joined 22 other bankers for the Oklahoma Bankers Association Emerging Leaders volunteer event at the Regional Food Bank of Oklahoma.

The OBA Emerging Leaders packed 558 cases of food, which translates to more than 13,250 meals for Oklahoma seniors in need of assistance.

The OBA conducts more than 70 educational programs and seminars each year, which reach more than 5,000 bankers across the state. The Association represents approximately 230 banks across the state and serves as the primary advocate for the banking industry. It's also heavily involved in fraud training and prevention as well as legal and compliance services and communications for its member banks.
