Carlisle is Executive Chairman of Mabrey Bank and Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of Mabrey Bancorporation, a family owned bank holding company. He presently serves on the Board of Directors of Trust Company of Oklahoma, Board of Advisors of the Tulsa Regional Chamber of Commerce, Board of Trustees of Philbrook Museum of Art and Board of Trustees of the University of Oklahoma Foundation.

Carlisle was a member of the Board of Directors of Life Assurance Company of Oklahoma City from 1980-2018. He was a member of the Board of Governors of Southern Hills Country Club from 2010-2015 and served as President in 2015. He served as a commissioner for Division One of the Oklahoma Department of Transportation from 2000-2011 and served on the selection committee for the Dean of the University of Oklahoma College of Law in 2010. He served as Treasurer of the Trinity Lutheran Church of Okmulgee, Oklahoma, from 1974-2009. He served on the Board of Directors of the Independent Community Bankers of America from 2001-2004 and the Oklahoma City Branch of the Federal Reserve Bank from 1998-2004. He served as a member of the State Banking Board from 1998-2000. He was a member of the Board of Directors of the Oklahoma Bankers Association, serving as Chairman in 1998. He was a three term Mayor of Okmulgee from 1986 to 1995. He also served as a member of the Bond Oversight Commission and the State Insurance Fund in the 1990s. He was a member of the Board of Trustees of the GRDA and the Mid America Industrial District from 1975-1980, serving as Vice Chairman in 1980. He served in the Air Force JAG Corps as an attorney from 1969 to January 1972, obtaining the rank of captain and being certified as a trial counsel, defense counsel and military judge. In Okmulgee, he served as President of the Chamber of Commerce, Chairman of the Board of Trustees of the Okmulgee Memorial Hospital, Chairman of the United Way and President of the Okmulgee Country Club. He served on the Board of Directors of First Bank of Haskell, Morris State Bank, Weleetka State Bank, Bank of Commerce (Wetumka) and Citizens Security Bank of Bixby.

Carlisle graduated from the University of Oklahoma with a Bachelor of Arts degree in 1966 and a Juris Doctorate degree in 1969, where he was on the Board of Editors of the Oklahoma Law Review and a member of the Order of the Coif. He attended the Wisconsin Graduate School of Banking from 1974-1976.
