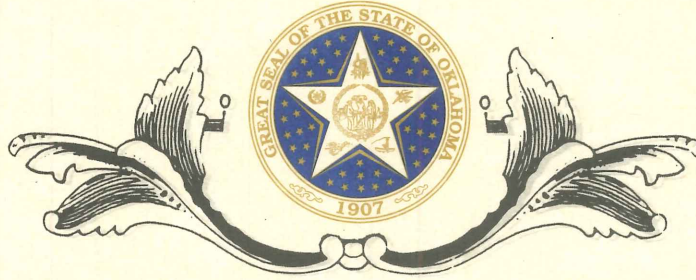

Whereas, These professionals work tirelessly with other local law enforcement agencies to uncover these criminal activities and protect the citizens of our great nation; and

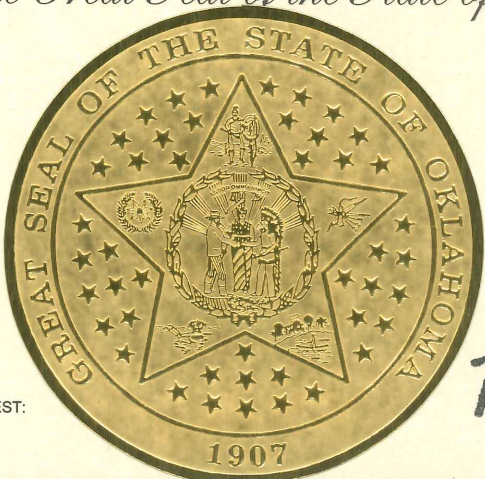
