Please include the following information with the Nominating Form:

- A detailed resume of the candidate's personal history and qualifications. This should include a Biographical Sketch of Nominee, a detailed summary of affiliations with financial institutions, positions held, degrees awarded, any awards or honors, examples of community involvement and service, and any other matters you believe will elevate the stature of the nominee when being considered by the Nominating Committee and, ultimately by his or her peers;
- In 350 words or less, explain why you believe this individual banker should be considered for induction into the Oklahoma Bankers Hall of Fame, including how his or her efforts have impacted the banking profession and the industry as a whole;
- A minimum of three letters of character reference and support for the nomination –
 (Letters should include name, address, phone and email for references and note their
 relationship to the Nominee, if any); and
- Provide a color photograph of nominee, preferably a .jpg image.

Note: Copies of any articles written by or about the Nominee are welcome.

In completing the nomination materials, assume the Nominating Committee and electors have no prior knowledge or awareness of the nominee. They should be able to rely solely on the material in the nomination form and letters of support to gauge the merit of selection of any individual who is nominated.

All nomination materials are due no later than Aug. 31. It is the responsibility of the nominator to ensure that all materials are submitted by this deadline.
